Do you know a CPA deserving of recognition for their outstanding achievements in business and industry? The OSCPAs Members in Industry Committee honors such professionals worthy of its prestigious Outstanding CPA in Business and Industry Award.

Nominations are due each year by July 1st. Your nominee will be sent an application packet requesting a resume and additional information on activities and contributions to the business community.

The nominee will also be recognized at the Annual Members Meeting and Awards Luncheon, receive coverage in the **CPAFOCUS** and have press releases sent to relevant newspapers. The winner will be nominated for the AICPA Outstanding CPA in Business and Industry Award.

Suggested criteria for selecting nominees is:

- A member of the OSCPAs and employed in business and industry.
- Distinguished by having made a significant contribution to the growth and success of his/her employer organization or a notable entrepreneurial achievement.
- Distinguished by having made significant contribution to the growth and enhancement of the profession.
- Nominated through a formal process by an OSCPAs member at large, committee or chapter.
