Nominees will be sent an application packet requesting a resume and information on their activities and contributions to the financial planning community. The award will be presented at the Annual Members Meeting, receive coverage in **CPAFOCUS** and the OSCPAs Wire, as well as have press releases sent to relevant newspapers.

Suggested criteria for selecting nominees is:

- A financial planning professional who is a member of the OSCPAs;
- Distinguished by having made a significant contribution to the growth, enhancement and public awareness of the CPA in the financial planning community; and
- Nominated through a formal process by an OSCPAs member at large, committee or chapter.
